- Brain tumors do not discriminate against age, gender, ethnicity, overall fitness or socioeconomic status – everyone is a potential candidate.
- Brain tumor symptoms may include seizures, chronic headaches, dizziness, nausea or impaired faculties including:
 - Vision, taste, smell, hearing or touch
 - Memory
 - Cognitive skills
 - Physical function and coordination
